Work off Monk's Hill beach

The two jack-up barges off Monk's Hill beach, the C57 Red Squirrel and C59 Emotion, will complete their work shortly and are expected to depart WC 16/9/19.

To prepare for the arrival of the HVDC cable laying barge Cable Enterprise in mid-October, we need to dig a temporary trench for the cables to be installed in up to 2km offshore from Monk's Hill beach.

This work will be carried out by the CAPALL MARA starting W/C 23rd September. The area will be reinstated afterwards and fully returned to normal by mid-November.

Further information will be given in the upcoming weeks regarding the demarcation of the area

HVAC cable burial

The JIF ARTEMIS is currently burying the HVAC cables laid between Monk's Hill Beach and Chilling earlier this year beneath the seabed. Our support vessel, GREEN QUEST, will be in the area assisting JIF ARTEMIS. Unlike the NP 289, this work will not involve anchors or associated visual markers.
