A preschool project that is ongoing and hopefully will be up and running by September 08.

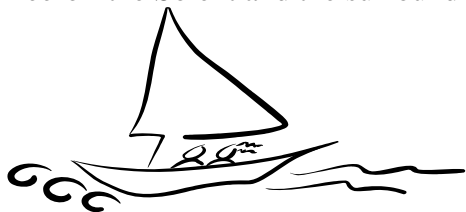

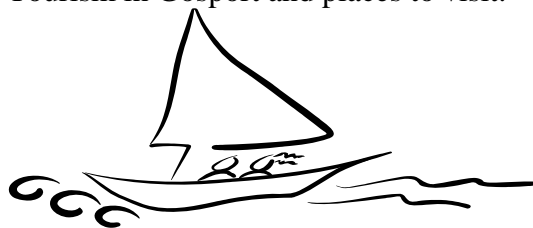
